Campground is on right about 1 mile. From Glenwood, turn left at sign for campground and follow above. (Hwy 46 and 280 intersect with Hwy 19) From there you turn left on Hwy 19 and left at campground sign. Camping fee: \$15.00 per night. The State meeting will be in conjunction with this campout.
